



The Southern Cayman model boasts architectural details with the American Colonial elevation designed by Henry Gonzalez of The Design Standard. A custom single-family home boasting a total building area of 4,508 square feet and 2,740 square feet of air conditioned living space, including a front veranda with 310 square feet, the covered rear veranda with 765 square feet and a three-car garage.

This impressive home offers a unique living space with 10-foot sliding glass doors in the great room that open to the rear veranda. You don't often see the dining room opening to the rear veranda, which captures the same picturesque views of the lake through the

double French doors.

The classic, casual elegance of this home is showcased in the outdoor living room, complete with see-through fireplace and just steps away is the outdoor kitchen making entertaining outside your top priority.

The Southern Cayman truly masters the great room concept for living and entertaining with its openness and inviting feel. The English garden interior design theme by Freestyle Interiors brings the finishes and textures throughout the home from the inside to the outside, as well as to the design of the custom pool with the four pedestal planters.

You are welcomed into this home with its study, three bedrooms and three and one-half baths. The master suite occupies an entire wing, offering access to the covered veranda through French doors. This home also features intricate coffered ceilings, detailed crown moldings and wood-lattice details evoking charm everywhere you look.
